First prize – \$500 and a limited edition bust of Rolf Boldrewood (value \$100)


Second prize – \$250





The Judges

Adelaide poet, Mike Ladd, is best known for his long-running Poetica program on ABC's Radio National. He has published eight collections, is a poetry mentor, judge, and a reviewer for the Sydney Morning Herald and Australian Book Review. Mike's poetry has been translated and published in several different languages, and his writing for radio has also been broadcast in many countries.



Dr David Reiter is an award-winning text and digital artist. He is the CEO and publisher of Interactive Publications Pty Ltd. Interactive Publications is the second largest publisher of literary titles in Queensland and publishes over thirty titles per year globally.



Competition Conditions

1

Judges will select the best entries in the following categories:

Prose – fiction with an Australian theme or flavour. Maximum of 2,500 words.

Poetry – in any form or style to a maximum of 80 lines with an Australian theme.

Entries must be original, must not have been previously published for cash payment, nor have been awarded first prize in any other written competition at the closing date of this competition.

3

An entry fee of \$10.00 must accompany each entry, along with an entry form for each piece of work.

Cheques or Money Orders must be made payable to Macquarie Regional Library.

Entries should be typed on one side only of white A4 paper. Prose entries are to be double spaced. No names on the entry, only on the entry form. Entrants should maintain a copy as entries will not be returned.
